This script will add all the tracks of a selected Grouping as "next to play" in the Party Shuffle playlist in their track number order.

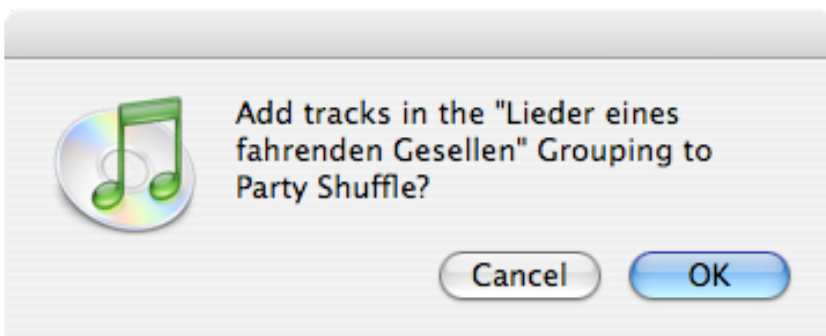
How to use:

Put this script in your iTunes Scripts folder. This is located in *user name > Library > iTunes*. If there is no folder named "Scripts" there, create one and put the script in it. It will then appear in iTunes' Script menu, where you can activate it by clicking on its name.

Note: The Party Shuffle playlist **must be playing** in order to add tracks to it with this script.

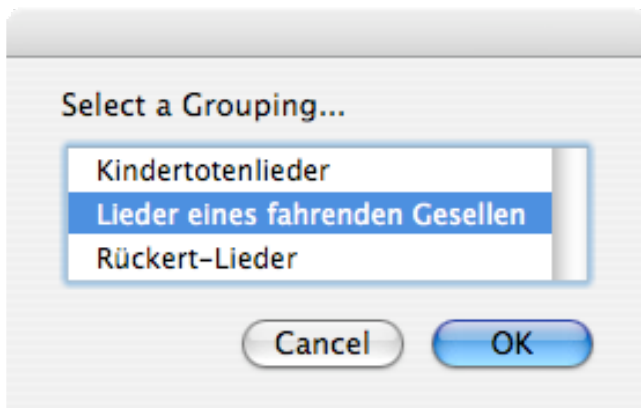
Run the script.

• If a single track is selected and its Grouping tag is not blank, that track's Grouping name will be used:



The selected track has the Grouping tag "Lieder eines fahrenden Gesellen".

• If no tracks are selected, or more than one track is selected, or a single selected track contains a blank Grouping field, then a choose box listing every Grouping in your iTunes library will be displayed. You can select a Grouping from the display. (This list, unlike the example below, is likely to be very large, so be prepared to scroll through it.)



Select a Grouping from all the Grouping tags in your library. Obviously, this example is quite small!

The script will then copy all the tracks which use that Grouping tag to the Party Shuffle playlist in their track number order as the next batch of tracks to play.

Notes:

- If the tracks to be added **do not have a track number**, they *may* be added in a random order.
- You can select a track displayed in the Party Shuffle's upcoming songs and those Grouping tracks will be added as next to play. (Of course, the selected track must have a Grouping tag.)
