This script lets you delete a specified number of characters from either the beginning *or* the ending of the Song Name, Album, Artist or Composer tag of each selected track.

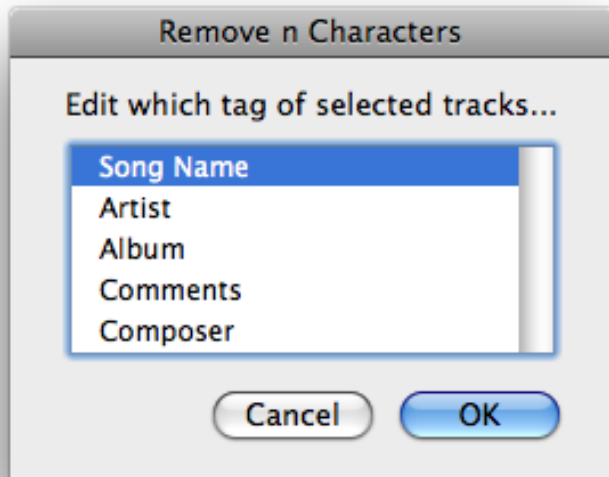
Installation:

To manually install: Put AppleScripts in your iTunes Scripts folder. This is located in *[user name] > Library > iTunes*. If there is no folder named "Scripts" there, create one and put the script(s) in it. AppleScripts will then appear in iTunes' Script menu, and can be activated by selecting by name and clicking. Be sure to also save this Read Me document in a safe and convenient place.

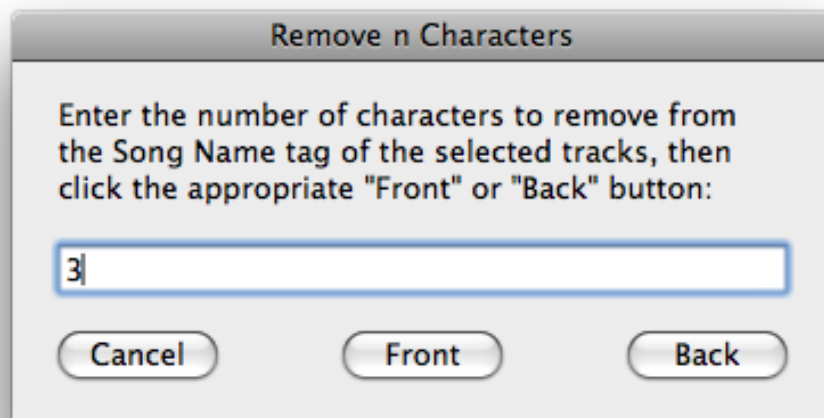
How to use:

Select one or more tracks whose **Song Name, Artist, Album, Comments** or **Composer** tag you wish to edit. Choose which tag of each selected track(s) you want to edit. Then enter the number of characters you want removed and click the "Front" or "Back" button.

For example, to remove the number prefixes from "01 *First Track*", "02 *Second Track*", "03 *Third Track*", and so on, select those tracks and run the script; choose "Song Name" from the first choose box:



At the next dialog box enter the number "3" (to account for the two digits and the space which precede the Song Name) and click the "Front" button, which will remove the first three characters of the selected tracks' names:
