AppleScript for iTunes

This script copies the track currently playing in iTunes to a playlist called "Favorites". If a "Favorites" playlist doesn't exist, it will create it for you.

How to use:

Put this script in your iTunes Scripts folder. This is located in *home > Library > iTunes*. If there is no Scripts folder there, create one and put the script in it. It will then appear in iTunes' Scripts Menu, where you can select it by clicking on its name. Or you can place it in your Script Menu folder *home > Library > Scripts* so it can be available system-wide.

While iTunes is playing, run the script when you want to send the currently playing song to the "Favorites" playlist.

If no "Favorites" playlist exists, the script will create one.

If a copy of the currently playing track is already in the "Favorites" playlist then it will not be re-copied.

Hack the Script:

You can edit this script to change the default playlist name from "Favorites" to something you find more appropriate.

· Open the script with Script Editor (double-click on the script)

• Near the top of the script you will see this line:

-- change the name from "Favorites" here if you like property FavePlaylist : "Favorites"

• Change "Favorites" to the name of a playlist you prefer, keeping the text inside the quotes.

• Save the script (Command-S) and quit Script Editor.
