This stay-open applet watches your playing tracks and when a new track starts playing displays a notification-sized panel whereby a Rating and/or Favorite or Suggest Less for the track can be entered.

Universal, for macOS 12 and later only.

Installation:

This script, "Rate Me! Rate Me!", is an **AppleScript applet** and can be run by double-clicking its icon in the Finder. Thus, it can be installed anywhere you find it convenient to access. However, it is probably best accessed from the Script menu of the Music app from where it can be launched by clicking its name.

To make an AppleScript available in the **Music app's** Script menu, install it in the Music app's "Scripts" folder. This is located at `[user name] / Library / Music / Scripts /`. The **Music app's** will look for AppleScripts in this folder.

*The user Library directory may be hidden by default. To make it visible, hold down the Option key on your keyboard and select **Go > Library** from the Finder.*

If the `[user name] / Library /` folder does not contain the "Music" folder or "Scripts" folder, then create them and put the script in the "Scripts" folder. AppleScripts will then

appear in the **Music app's** Script menu and can be activated by selecting by name and clicking.

Be sure to also save this Read Me document in a safe and convenient place.

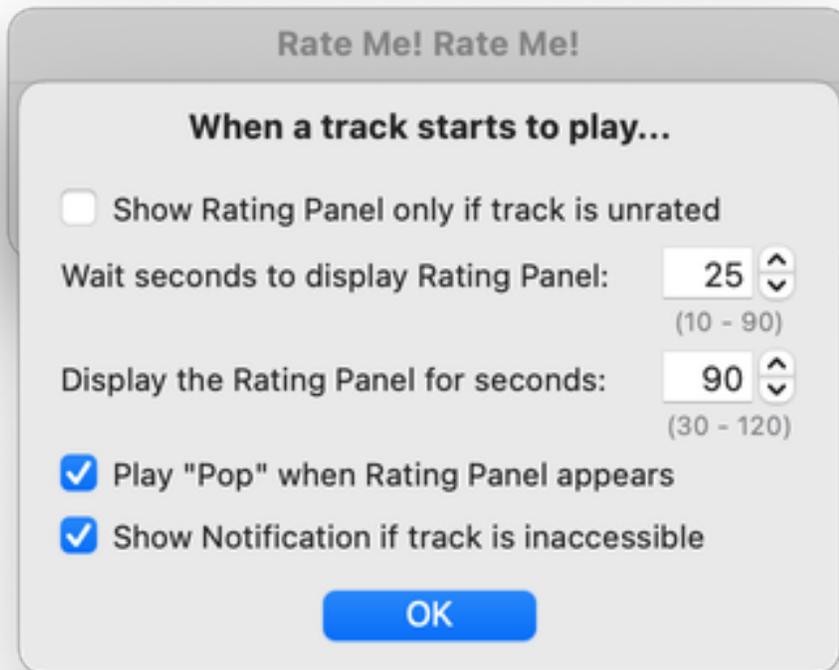

How to use:

Launch the app by selecting it from the Music app's Script menu or by double-clicking its icon in the Finder.

Initially, a window will display. Position this window where it will be less likely to interfere with your work but still be noticeable. (My personal experience has been that with a big screen it is less effective when placed in a corner but better when positioned closer to the center.)

If necessary, click the **Settings** button to set the timer and other options:



Settings:

- **Show Rating Panel only if track is unrated** - Ignores tracks that are already rated.
- **Wait seconds to display Rating Panel** - Wait *this many* seconds after a song starts playing before displaying the Rating Panel interface. This gives you time to actually *hear* the song before considering a rating. During operation, each "wait" period may be slightly longer than what is entered.
- **Display the Rating Panel for seconds** - The Rating Panel will only remain visible for *this many* seconds per song and then disappear.
- **Play "Pop" when Rating Panel appears** - The "Pop" **system sound** will precede the appearance of the Rating Panel.
- **Show Notification if track is inaccessible** - The rating tags of some non-local audio files and Apple Music tracks cannot be affected by AppleScript. When this is checked, a Notification indicating that the current track is such a track will display

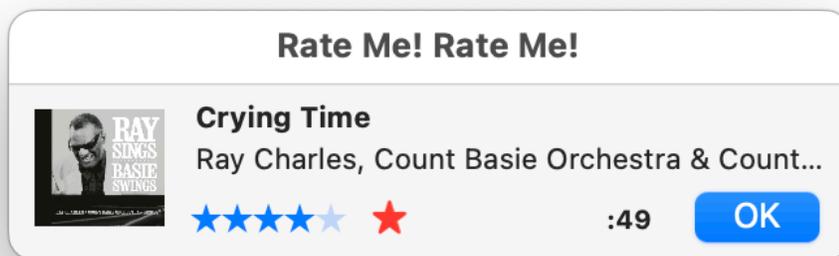
instead of the Rating Panel. Otherwise, nothing will display.

When settings are the way you want them, click the Settings panel's **OK** button. These settings will be stored between launches.

(This Settings panel can be accessed later from the "Settings..." menu but is probably most sensible to set up at launch.)

Then click the **OK** button to dismiss the initial window and engage track monitoring.

Now, when a Music track begins playing the applet will display the Rating Panel over whatever application you are working in (part of the script's charm is its intrusiveness) to let you enter a rating, Favorite or Suggest Less:



Like the ratings widget in Music, just click-and-drag over the stars to change the rating. (Half-star ratings are not supported.)

Click on the ★ to cycle through Un-Favorite/Un-Suggest Less, Favorite and Suggest Less settings.

- Click the **OK** button to dismiss the Rating Panel and any changes made will be applied to the currently playing track.
- **For best results:** The script is intended to be used while you *casually* listen to music. Allow the tracks in Music to play in their entirety; don't skip around.
- **if you choose not to rate the current track** you can simply ignore the Rating Panel and it will be out of your way in a few moments (or however long you set it to display in the **Settings**). The countdown-timer will keep you aware of when the

Rating Panel will disappear.

Do-Over

Any time a track is playing, single-click the applet's icon in the Dock to re-display the Rating Panel for the current track (if possible). In such a case, you must close the Rating Panel manually by clicking the "OK" button.

You can Quit the application anytime by right-clicking its icon in the Dock and selecting **Quit** from the menu, or choosing "Quit" from its menu, or by pressing **Command-Q** while the applet is active.
