

Show Me The Metadata

This script will display the audio metadata and the Spotlight metadata for either the file of a selected track in the Music app or a drag-and-dropped or user-selected audio file. Includes additional features to display embedded artwork and activate the Finder's Information Window for the file.

Universal, for macOS 12 and later only.

Installation:

This script, "Show Me The Metadata", is an **AppleScript applet/droplet** and can be run by double-clicking its icon in the Finder **or** by dragging Finder items to its icon. Thus, it can be installed anywhere you find it convenient to access. However, it may be best accessed from the Script menu of the Music app, from where it can be launched by clicking its name.

To make an AppleScript available in your **Music app's** Script menu, install it in the Music "Scripts" folder. This is located at *[user name] / Library / Music / Scripts /*. **Music app** will look for AppleScripts in this folder.

The user Library directory may be hidden by default. To make it visible, hold down

*the Option key on your keyboard and select **Go > Library** from the Finder.*

If the *[user name] / Library /* folder does not contain the "Music" folder or "Scripts" folder, then create them and put the script(s) in the "Scripts" folder. AppleScripts will then appear in the Music app's Script menu, and can be activated by selecting by name and clicking. Be sure to also save this Read Me document in a safe and convenient place.

How to use:

As an Applet:

Launch the script by double-clicking its icon in the Finder or—if correctly installed in the "Scripts" folder as described above—selecting it from the Music app's Script menu.

[Choose a track in Music](#) - Clicking the "Get Track" toolbar button anytime will try to access the file associated with **currently selected track** in the Music app (or the first track of a multiple selection). Tracks that do not have local files will be ignored.

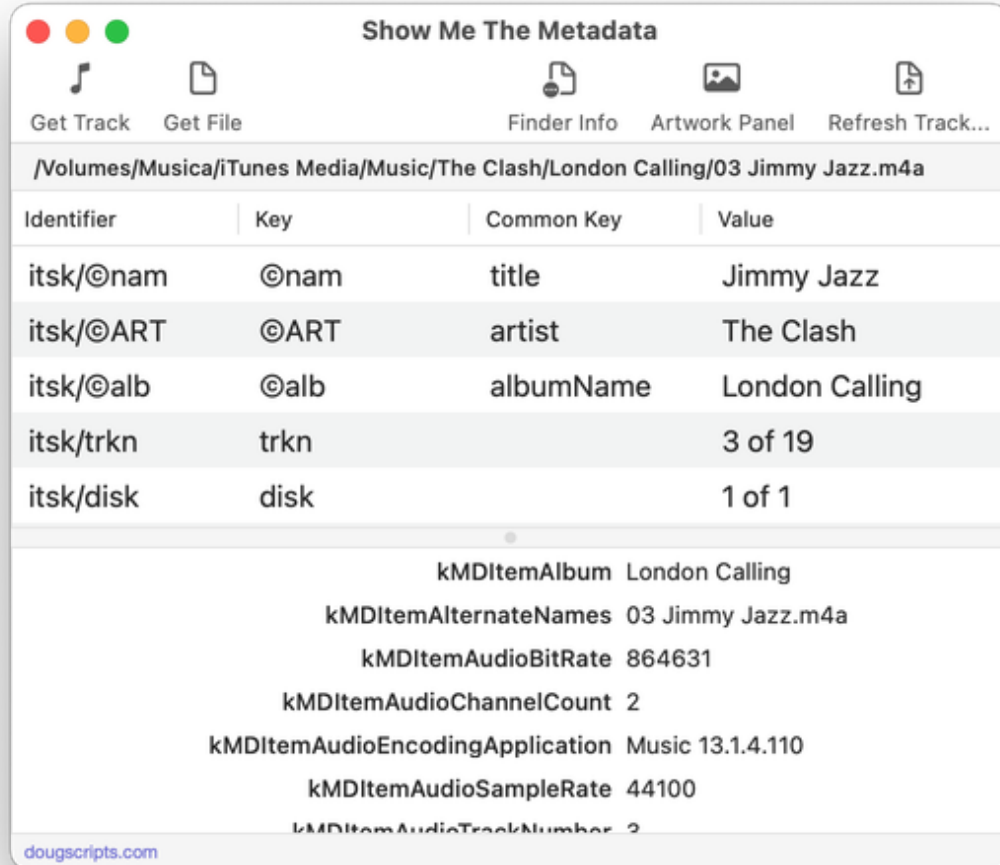
OR

[Choose a file in the Finder](#) - Click the "Get File" toolbar button to display an Open Panel. Navigate to a sound file, select it and click the "Choose" button.

Drag-and-Drop:

[Once the app has launched](#), a track from the Music app or a file in the Finder can be drag-and-dropped directly onto the main window anytime.

If the chosen file is accessible and contains **audio metadata** that data will be displayed in the **top half** of the main window. **Spotlight** information will be displayed in the **bottom half**:



The window as well as the heights of each display areas are resizable. The display areas are scrollable.

If **image data** was available in the audio metadata (so-called "embedded artwork") it can be displayed in a separate window. Click the "Artwork Panel" toolbar button to toggle this panel's visibility.

To display the **Finder Information Window** for the file, click the "Finder Info" toolbar button.

Refresh Tags from File's Metadata:

This option uses the Music app's AppleScript command called **refresh**. It will repopulate the tags of a track with the current metadata from its file.

This may be useful if the file's metadata has been changed by another application but

not yet updated for the track's entry by the Music app.

This option is only available if a track has been "gotten" or dragged from the Music app.

Quit the applet by pressing **⌘Q**.
