AppleScript for iTunes

Use this applet to launch and quit iTunes: when run while iTunes is playing/paused, it will remember the currently playing track and quit iTunes; when run next it will start iTunes and play the remembered track.

Installation:

This script should be installed wherever it can be conveniently accessed. Since it is used to launch iTunes, you probably don't want to install it in the ~/Library/iTunes/Scripts/ folder.

How to use:

Note on location: this applet can be run from anywhere on your computer by double-clicking its icon. You may want to place it in the Dock to access it when iTunes is not running.

To Quit and Remember: While iTunes is running, activate the applet either by selecting it from iTunes' Script menu or double-clicking it in the Finder. If a track is playing in iTunes you can choose to have the applet "remember" it. iTunes will then quit.

To Start and Play: To play the "remembered" track, activate the applet while iTunes is

not running. The applet will launch iTunes and then begin to play the track it "remembered" the last time it was used to quit iTunes.

- If the applet is used to quit iTunes and no track is playing, nothing will be "remembered".
- If the "remembered" track is set to "Remember playback position", the track will begin playing where it was stopped.
- If the playlist containing the track is altered or the track is removed from it, the script will fail when used to re-launch iTunes.
