For iTunes 11+/macOS 10.12+ Find more free AppleScripts and info on writing your own at Doug's AppleScripts for iTunes.

This script will display a sortable list of playlists from the selected source along with their size, time, number of tracks and loved/disliked status. Additionally, the script can export a text file listing that information.

For macOS 10.12 and later only.

Installation:

This script is an **AppleScript applet** and can be run by double-clicking its icon in the Finder. However, it is probably best accessed from the iTunes Script menu.

Put AppleScripts in your iTunes "Scripts" folder. This is located at [user name] / Library / iTunes / Scripts / .


The user Library directory is hidden by default. To make it visible, hold down the Option key on your keyboard and select **Go > Library** from the Finder.

If the [user name] / Library / folder does not contain the "iTunes" or "Scripts" folders then then create them and put the script(s) in the "Scripts" folder. AppleScripts will then appear in iTunes' Script menu, and can be activated by selecting by name and clicking. Be sure to also save this Read Me document in a safe and convenient place.

How to use:

While iTunes is runniing, launch the applet and after a few moments a window like this will appear:



The initial list of Playlists will be from the current iTunes Library. If any devices are mounted and accessible via iTunes then they will be listed in the Source popup at the top of the window.

Whenever a device is selected, its **free space and capacity** will be displayed in the lower-right corner.

Filter the list for specific playlists by name by entering text in the Search field.

The script does not monitor iTunes for changes to any playlists or devices. If you add or remove playlists or devices or add or remove their tracks, you should Refresh the list by choosing *File > Refresh* or by pressing **Command-R**.

To **export a tab-delimited text file** listing of the playlists in the selected Source,

choose *File > Export* or press **Command-E**. A Save Panel will allow you to select a location for the exported text file. This file can be opened in a text editor or spreadsheet app.

Double-clicking a playlist in the list will select it in iTunes.

The **total size of any selected playlists** will appear at the bottom of the list. The script does not take into consideration the possibility that the same tracks may be included in any two or more playlists; size and time are based on the individual properties of each playlist.
