Remove Duplicates

This script removes duplicate tracks from the selected playlist.

When a file is added to iTunes, it is assigned a unique **database ID**. For example, if you drag the same track to a playlist two or more times each instance of the track will have the same **database ID**. This script will delete all but one track of any tracks in the selected playlist which have the same **database ID**.

This script does not delete tracks from any iTunes Master library ("Music", "Movies", "Audiobooks", and so on) only the selected playlist.

This script does not identify or eliminate duplicate files.

This script cannot delete files.

How to use:

Put this script in your iTunes Scripts folder. This is located in *user name* > Library > iTunes. If there is no folder named "Scripts" there, create one and put the script in it. It will then appear in iTunes' Script menu, where you can activate it by clicking on its name.
