

Rip A Few My Way v4.0

AppleScript for iTunes

Find more **free** AppleScripts and info on writing your own at Doug's AppleScripts for iTunes.

This script applet lets you rip all tracks or a selection of tracks from a CD using your choice of available encoders without having to change your iTunes Import Settings. Your original preferred encoder will remain set after running the script. You can optionally create a new playlist in which to copy the new tracks after ripping as well.

Installation:

To manually install: Put AppleScripts in your iTunes Scripts folder. This is located in *[user name] > Library > iTunes*. If there is no folder named "Scripts" there, create one and put the script(s) in it. AppleScripts will then appear in iTunes' Script menu, and can be activated by selecting by name and clicking. Be sure to also save this Read Me document in a safe and convenient place.

How to use:

Insert a CD and let it mount in iTunes. Launch the script by clicking its name in the iTunes Scripts menu.

Follow the prompts.

Notes:

- If multiple CDs are mounted you will be asked to choose which CD to use.
- If a selection of CD tracks are highlighted then only these CD tracks will be imported. If no CD tracks are selected then all CD tracks will be imported. Check-boxes (enable boxes) settings are ignored.
- For best results, iTunes Preferences should be set to "Show CD" when a CD is inserted. This is under the *General* tab of iTunes' Preferences window.
