Set No Cover v1.0

AppleScript for iTunes

This script will apply a [no cover] graphic as the artwork to the selected iTunes tracks.

Also included is a droplet that will enable you to convert your own artwork as the default artwork used by the script.

How to install:

Put the "Set No Cover" *folder* in your iTunes Scripts folder. This is located in *user name* > Library > iTunes. If there is no folder named "Scripts" there, create one and put the "Set No Cover" folder in it.

The "Set No Artwork" folder contains the **Set No Cover** script, the **Drop To Make No Cover Artwork** droplet, the **original no_cover artwork** folder and the **no_cover.pict** file. Please leave this folder intact.

How to use:

Select some tracks and run the Set No Cover script from the iTunes Script menu. The no_cover graphic will be applied to the selected tracks.

Use your own graphic:

Create your own no-cover graphic (in virtually any format) and drag-and-drop it on the "Drop To Make No Cover" droplet. This AppleScript droplet will convert your graphic—if possible—to a 200 x 200 pixel PICT file and replace the current no_cover.pict in the "Set No Cover" folder where the script expects to find it. A copy of the original no_cover.pict file is stored in the "original no_cover artwork" folder.
