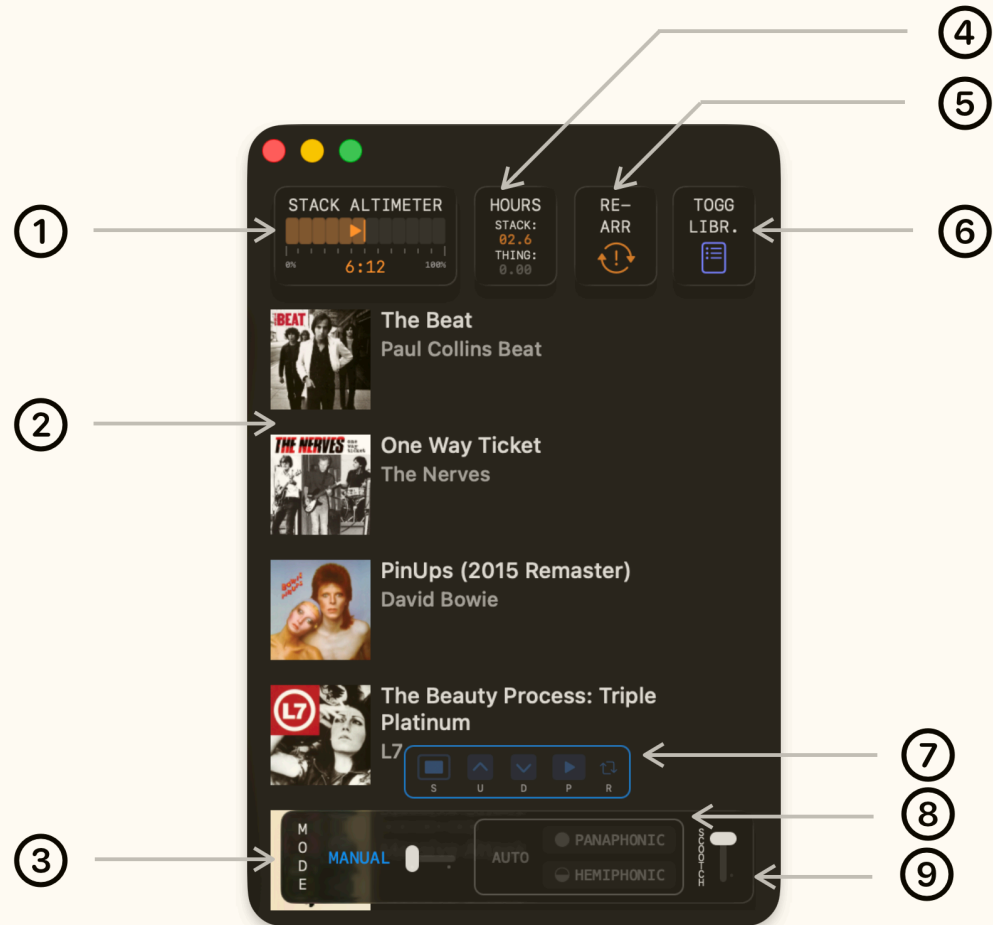


The Yer Stack Desktop Audio File Album Player (DAFAP)

Hey, is that Yer Stack? Yep!

- ★ Listen to your audio file albums in Automatic or Manual modes. Yer Stack plays a stack of albums over and over. Until whenever!
- ★ Plays up to twenty albums Panaphonically+ or Hemiphonically+ and can provide many hours of continuous music. Or can be less.
- ★ Yer Stack stays completely and impossibly unorganized by re-arranging Yer Stack's album order unexpectedly during use.

- ★ *Be careful!* Freshen Yer Stack with new albums every few days. You don't want to get driven completely crazy by the same albums playing all the time. In fact, about a half an hour *just before that occurs* is a good time to freshen Yer Stack.
- ★ Easily access Wikipedia articles for the playing album.
- ★ Simple instructions will make you a boss expert in minutes.

Yer Stack Operating Instructions

Be sure all transit screws are turned *fully* counter-clockwise before adding albums to Yer Stack. The transit screws are located underneath the unit.

ADDING ALBUMS TO YER STACK

1. When launched for the very first time in yer home, Yer Stack will index the default audio file Music library.
2. In the Library View (not shown), click on an album to add it to the Yer Stack View (2).
3. Get that Library View out of the way to reveal the Yer Stack View (2) by clicking TOGG LIBR. (6) or by pressing Command-L on the keyboard.
4. *Optional:* A folder of audio files can be added to Yer Stack by using the "Open a Folder..." File menu command or via drag-and-drop.

AUTOMATIC PLAY

1. Slide the Operating Mode Slider (3) to the AUTO position.
2. Select PANAPHONIC+ mode or HEMIPHONIC+ mode by clicking on the appropriate Auto Mode Select button (8).
3. In AUTO mode, things will hop around in Yer Stack (2) a little from time to time. Nothing to worry about. You'll probably never notice.
4. To STOP Yer Stack while AUTO playing in PANAPHONIC+ mode or HEMIPHONIC+ mode, slide the Operating Mode Slider (3) to the MANUAL position.

MANUAL PLAY

1. Slide the Operating Mode Slider (3) to the MANUAL position.
2. Conventional Transport Controls (7) will become available: Stop, Previous, Next, Play/Pause, Repeat.
3. To play an album in Yer Stack (2), first select it by clicking on it. Its tracks will be exposed and those Transport Controls (7) will be looking pretty good about now.

STACK HEIGHT AND STACK CEILING

Yer Stack's Stack Ceiling is factory-set to 12, allowing Yer Stack to have

as many as 12 albums "stacked" at any time.

To add a new album to Yer Stack when Yer Stack Height has reached the Stack Ceiling, another album will be removed from Yer Stack *at random*. Or, an album can be removed from Yer Stack first, by selecting it and then pressing Command-D on the keyboard.

To change the Stack Ceiling officially, go to Settings. There's a thing there to do it.

The STACK ALTIMETER (1) displays yer Stack Height-to-Ceiling Ratio. Self-explanatory.

Yer Stack can be wiped *complètement* by pressing Command-Delete on your keyboard.

SWAPPING THE LIBRARY

A different directory of Artist/Album-arranged folders of audio files can be assigned as the default Library in Settings. Audio files must be in an accessible location. And in that Artist/Album folder arrangement, too. ¡Important!

KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS *(MANUAL mode only)*

Play/Pause - spacebar
Stop - Command-.
Previous - up arrow
Next - down arrow

Close Exposed Album - Command-W
Wikipedia Look-Up - Command-I

Note: Avoid handling audio files. Swaths of greasy grime from human fingertips can encourage corrosion and degrade audio quality.
