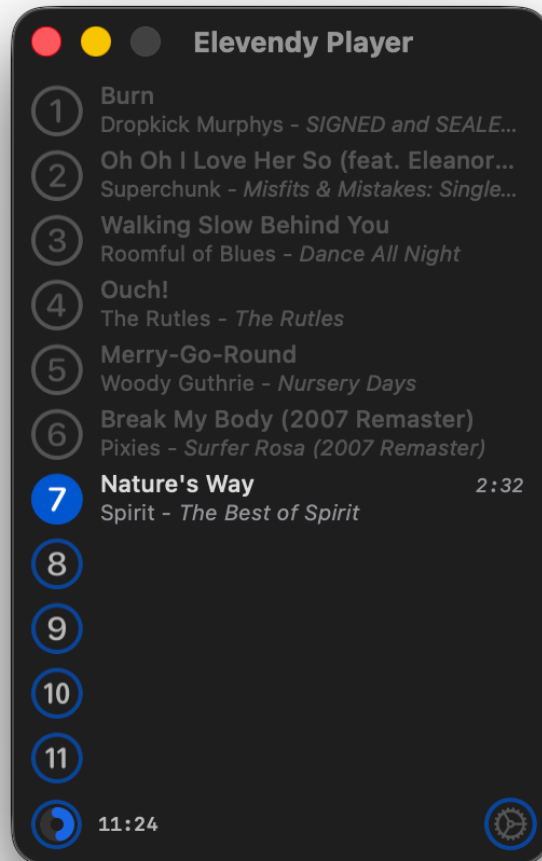


Elevendy

Elevendy plays a batch of eleven random local audio files that are between 1:30 - 2:40 in length. Then, if you want, it will do another one. And so on.

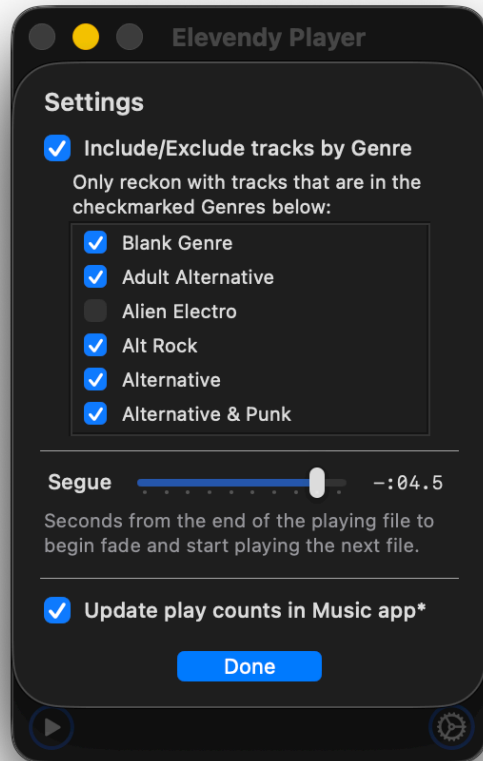

How to use:

Launch the app. On first use, the Settings should be, uh, set. Click the gear button or choose "Settings" from the File menu:



- **Include/Exclude tracks by Genre** - The initial pool of files will only include the genres that are checkmarked in the list. (The list is scrollable and the panel is resizable.)

- **Segue** - As it says, the seconds from the end of the current track to begin fading and start the next track. I find 3.5 - 4.5 comfortable. Train wrecks are always possible and unavoidable.

- **Update play counts in Music app*** - *If possible*, the play count and played date of tracks played in Elevandy will be updated in the Music app.

Click the "Done" button when Settings are satisfactory. Settings can be accessed anytime Elevandy is not playing.

Press the play button to start playing an elevandy.

There is no Stop button. You have to wait. Or quit the app.
